Judy's quilts have been the focus of shows at The National Quilt Museum in Paducah, Kentucky, the Iowa Quilt Museum in Winterset, The Rocky Mountain Quilt Museum in Golden, Colorado, the AQS Show in Des Moines, and more. She has taught and lectured nationally. Judy Martin is best known as a quilt designer. She has published more than 1000 original block and quilt patterns to date. Judy's familiarity with traditional blocks informs and inspires her designs

Her goal is to create patterns that sparkle with a wholly new idea while remaining surprisingly simple. She says she isn't done yet, so you can look forward to more designs from her in years to come.
