Registration

Registration is open now! There are a limited number of spaces available for each session. Registrations are accepted on a first-come-first-served basis.

Camp Fees and Payment

The camp fee is \$100. A 50% deposit is required by May 10, or, if after May 10, within 5 days of returning this registration. The remaining 50% is due by May 28. Confirmation of registration and payment will be emailed to you.

Member Discount

Those with Kalona Historical Society memberships will be eligible for a discount of 10% per child. Those with a single or senior membership can designate one camper to receive the 10% discount.

Multiple Children Discount

A discount for multiple children in the same family will be as follows: Camper 1 - \$100, Camper 2 - \$90, Camper 3 - \$80, etc.

Communication

All camp communication will be sent via email. You will receive an email confirmation of your registration. Please make sure you receive this. If you do not, we may have mistyped your address. Wait List

If a grade level and session are full, you will be placed on a waitlist. You will be contacted via email if a spot opens.

Cancellations

Cancellations made by May 14 will receive a 100% refund. Cancellations made between May 15 and May 28 will receive a 50% refund. Refunds will not be given after May 28. Cancellations must be made in writing and sent to kalonatours@gmail.com.

Covid-19

By sending your child to camp, you agree to abide by all of the museum's policies and procedures regarding Covid-19. *Campers are required to wear face masks or face coverings. *Each group will have a maximum of 6 campers, plus 2 teachers. *Groups will be distanced from each other as much as possible. *Handwashing and/or hand sanitizer will be available. *Camp areas will be cleaned and disinfected between each group. *Any additions and/or changes to the policies will be communicated with you via email.

By participating in Kalona Historical Society Camp, I acknowledge that the museum has permission to use photos and videos of my child to promote the camp. Your child's name will never be linked with the photo or video.

Authorization for Treatment

In case of an emergency and I cannot be reached, the camp director will contact the emergency contact listed. In the case of a medical emergency, Kalona First Responders will be called. If no one can be reached, the camp director has the authority to allow the First Responders to administer care. If further treatment is needed, the camp director has my permission to make decisions on transportation, x-rays, routine tests, and treatments.

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
